

Tips for Choosing a Photographer

Choosing a photographer is one of the most important aspects of your wedding day. You will be relying on him/her to capture your most treasured memories of the biggest day of your life. Reputation

Ask family and friends for recommendations. Who have they used or seen? Has this person done weddings successfully and how many? How long have they been a photographer and what kind of training have they had? Do they have any reviews or customer testimonies?

What Services Do They Offer

Are they offering only digital images or printed images as well? Printed images must be of a higher quality to print well, while lower quality images show up fine in online/digital output locations.

Are the images you will receive edited and are the edited images indivdually or batch processed? Are they retouched for optimized beauty?

Are they offering two photographers for your day? What is the skillset of the second photographer? Many photographers will hire a second shooter. The second person is often a photographer in training.

Instinct

Set up a meeting with your proposed photographer(s) and ask them questions. Browse their websites and make sure you really like their work.

Make sure you feel comfortable with them personally. Can you relate to them and do they answer your questions and put you at ease about your day?
